The David L. Williams Memorial Lectureship Award

This award was established to recognize young and promising investigators who have achieved independence by publishing manuscripts as the senior, corresponding author, who have obtained independent funding, and who have demonstrated the potential to become an outstanding scientist.

Eligible Applicants

Instructor or Assistant Professor faculty holding a Ph.D. and/or M.D. and working in academic research in the general area of lipid and lipoprotein metabolism and atherosclerosis are eligible.

Applicant should submit: 1) a manuscript that has been published within one year of the application deadline for this year's award 2) curriculum vitae, and 3) letter from the Department Chair (no more than 2 pages) confirming the independence of the investigator, including sufficient information confirming applicant's independent grant support, and that applicant has held a faculty appointment no longer than 5 years.

AWARD**

The winning applicant will make a 35 minute presentation at the meeting on the manuscript topic, and will receive a cash and travel award.
