The Roger Davis Investigator Award for Transitional Faculty

This award was established to recognize promising investigators early in their careers, who have demonstrated potential to become an outstanding independent scientist. Evidence of progress towards independence includes manuscripts as corresponding author and acquisition of transition-to-independent funding, such as the AHA Scientist Development Grant or the like.

Eligible Applicants

Junior faculty at the Instructor or Assistant Professor level holding a Ph.D. and/or M.D., with at least two years of postdoctoral work but no more than 3 years in first faculty position, with clear evidence of progress towards independence as indicated in department chairman's or mentor's letter.

Applicant should submit: 1) abstract for a poster presentation 2) curriculum vitae, and 3) chairman's (mentor's) letter (no more than two pages).

AWARD**

The winning applicant will make a 10-minute talk with poster presentation at the meeting on the submitted abstract and will receive a cash and travel award.
